

Poster presentation for PhD students of IUC-JU programme

Around the time of the JSCM of 17 September, we want to hold a poster session for all the PhD students and also want to link to it a poster competition: the best poster will gain a fee of 1,000 euro that can be used for travel expenses related to the attendance of a conference or a training.

Below, we give instructions for the format of the poster; apart from that you are free to let your creativity play, although the topic should be (a part) of your PhD research.

The size of the poster should be A0 (841 mm by 1189 mm) . We add such a format in powerpoint for the people wanting to work with powerpoint. The smallest letter size should be 48 pt in times new roman, so that we can still print the poster in a readable way in A4 format (for the booklet of posters).

The three logos (IUC-JU, JU and VLIR) should occur on the poster; I have added them already in the powerpoint template, but we will provide you soon with better quality logos.

Following information should occur on the poster:

- Title
- Name of PhD student and supervisor(s)
- The following sections
 - Introduction
 - Objectives
 - Materials and methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
 - Reference

The last line (as in the powerpoint template) should read

This is PhD work done in the context of the IUC-JU project

You should provide the poster to PSU that will put it on the server no later than May 31, so that we can still provide you with feedback. The format you can deliver is either PPT, JPEG or PDF (but then high quality, so that pictures will still come out nicely).
